

PUBLIC NOTICE

At the regular meeting of the Village of Andover Board of Trustees on February 8, 2022 The Board adopted, by Roll Call Vote, Resolution #2 of 2022 hereby abolishing the Office of Village Justice and Village Court Clerk upon expiration of the current term ending on December 2, 2024.

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 3-301(2)(a) of the Village Law of the State of New York, the Board of Trustees of any Village by resolution subject to permissive referendum may abolish the Office of Village Justice and Village Court Clerk to take effect upon the expiration of the current term of such office, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees finds that the needs of the Village for the prosecution of violations under the Village Code can be handled effectively by the Town Court.

BE IF FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution is adopted subject to permissive referendum, and the Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish and post notice of such adoption in accordance with law; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED this resolution will be effective upon the date of the expiration of the period for referendum (30 days), or upon a referendum vote supporting the abolition of the Office of the Village Justice and Village Court Clerk.
